

Broadstairs Folk Week takes place in a beautiful unspoilt seaside resort, blessed with seven sandy bays, a host of friendly pubs and restaurants and an unbeatable atmosphere. With over 70 events a day - you'll find something to entertain you from early in the morning till late at night. All events are included in your Season Ticket, just make sure you turn up in good time.

In the middle of the town's park is the festival's main venue - the 600 seater Concert Marquee. Here you can enjoy all the headline acts such as Barbara Dickson in proper theatre style seating with a top-notch sound system. More intimate acoustic events are sprinkled around the town including the Sailing Club, the Methodist Church and the historic Crampton Tower.

Folk Week has over 70 workshops during the week and if you buy a Season Ticket they are included in the price. In 2011 you can sing with the Spooky Men, meet the Bowed Psaltery, learn Bhangra dance, brush up your banjo technique and much more.

The Festival Campsite is a ten-minute walk from the town, so you can arrive in Broadstairs, pitch your tent, park your car and forget about it until it's time to leave.

The special Craft & Music Fair is a very popular part of Folk Week with a huge variety of ceramics, clothing, musical instruments, paintings, jewellery and gifts and entry is free. Young festival-goers are well-catered for and can get involved at any level - the Hobby Horse Club entertains families every morning at the Bandstand with the ever-popular Hooten Hooters and Clarence the Dragon.

We have singing games, a toddler's singaround, sticky fingers crafts, circus workshops and a special children's show. Wonderful Panic Circus are ringmasters of mayhem and teach everything from unicycling to Diablo.

Masses of Morris throng through the town and the Torchlight Procession blazes through the streets on Saturday night.
